



Hall-of-Fame Statistics

Jeff Ferrand spent a significant amount of time converting historical DPBA Hall-of-Fame statistics into an electronic version. As you can imagine, with the exception of recent years, this information was kept manually in a notebook organized by year and DPBA member. For the first time, I'm happy to present unofficial DPBA Hall-of-Fame Statistics. Please note these are unofficial because the statistical information is 1986-present and you can't compile a list like this without making a few mistakes. I'm certain there are misspellings, errors, omissions, and other miscellaneous mistakes. Please let me know if you have any questions or find any mistakes and I will update the information appropriately.

To qualify to be on the HOF ballot for Superior Performance, you must meet 1 of 3 criteria: 1) Accumulate 30 HOF points. 2) Accumulate 3000 BOY pts and either a win or BOY Award. 3) Any combination of Wins and BOY Awards that total 4. HOF points are awarded as follows: A) 6 pts for a BOY Award. B) 4 pts for a Win. C) 3 pts for High Qualifier. D) 2 pts for 2nd place. E) 1 pt for 3rd place. F) 1 pts for every 500 BOY pts. Once on the ballot, you must receive a "Yes" vote on 3/4 of eligible ballots returned by Governing Body members.

Having said all of that, I hope you find this list interesting and informative. I know that I did. You will find there are a significant number of members who have either qualified to be on the HOF ballot or are extremely close to qualifying to be on the HOF ballot. This list includes, but is not limited to, John Deantonis, Jim Reisberg, Todd Turcotte, Mark Callahan, Doug Shipley, Roy Cochefski Jr., Curt Johnson, Dave Marsh, John Depalma, Paul Grohs, and Larry Aley.

I'm sure we will do some additional historical research, specifically as it relates to individuals who are close to being on the HOF ballot. There have been no official discussions or decisions regarding our next HOF Banquet. That event is typically organized in conjunction with the WNDA and occurs every 3-5 years depending on the number of individuals to be inducted.
